- 1) Prospective authors are invited to submit original full papers WITHOUT authors' names and affiliations, in English, of 3 - 4 pages in standard IEEE two-column format only, reporting their original work and results, applications, and/or implementation in one or more of the listed areas.
- 2) Papers must be submitted online only through the submission system of the conference website.
- 3) At least one author of each accepted paper MUST register and present the paper at the conference in order that the paper is to be included in the program. The program will also be submitted for inclusion in the IEEE Xplore. All accepted papers will be submitted for inclusion into IEEE Xplore as well as SCOPUS indexing.
